






Your GCSEs

- Majority of courses are 'linear' exams take place at the end of the course.
- Remodelled GCSE courses are 'robust'
- Reduced coursework (controlled assessment) component in most subjects.
- Marks for SPAG Spelling, Punctuation & Grammar
- Grading system: 9 1 has replaced A*-G in all GCSEs

How the GCSE grading structure compares to the old one



EBacc (English Baccalaureate)

- The Department for Education is aiming for a large percentage of students to complete the EBacc combination of subjects at GCSE.
- The EBacc recognises students that achieve Grade 5 or above in:
 - English
 - Maths
 - Science Combined Science / Separate sciences / Computer Science
 - History / Geography
 - Modern Foreign Language (MFL)

Almost essential for students wishing to apply to top universities (i.e. <u>think seriously about the implications</u> <u>of</u> not taking a MFL)



Core or GCSE PRE?

 Students will be asked to choose if they wish to follow PRE (Philosophy, Religion and Ethics) through to a GCSE or undertake Core PRE lessons


Option 1:

Core PRE (2 lessons) + Core PE (4 lessons)






Options subjects

At least one of these choices must include **Geography** or **History** (although you may do both)







Should I choose a language?

- The global tech industry is booming
- Languages give you the edge
- Employers know language students are quick learners
- Languages boost confidence



Options subjects

Separate Science - this is ideally for students who wish to pursue Science at A-level (although you can do this without taking Separate Science).

Maths content is significant in Physics and Chemistry papers. If you follow this you could get up to 13hrs of Science (Core lessons + 1 option)

Computer Science - challenging programming concepts and problem solving — need to be good at Maths (ideally in Sets 1, 2 or 3)



Subjects and class sizes

Maximum class sizes – there is a limit on the class sizes that we will allocate students to. Some classes are restricted by health and safety (e.g. DT), by the equipment available or a maximum group size.

Course selection – if a class has too few people selecting it then will be unable to run it as it is not economically viable.

If a class has too many students selecting it then we will look to see if we can run additional classes, if not we will initially use the subject priorities that students have ranked their choices by


