

Y10 Work Shadowing Information Sheet Tuesday 11th July 2024

How and when to make contact

Think about how you would prefer to contact a company, but also think about what might be best for the organisation you are making contact with. Smaller businesses might prefer you to drop in or phone up; larger companies might prefer an email or letter. If you're not sure, you could contact them to find out who usually organises work experience and check the best way to arrange it.

If you're popping in or phoning, try to avoid a company's busy time of day. For example, primary school offices tend to be very busy at the start and end of the school day; garages tend to be busy when customers drop off and pick up their cars before and after work; shops might be busier on Saturdays.

Top tips

- However you choose to contact an employer, it is important that you make a good impression.
- Try contacting several employers, not just one.
- If you don't hear back after emailing or leaving your details, try contacting them once more.
- If they say no, thank them for their time, but keep going and contact someone else.
- Once an employer says yes, make sure you have the details requested in the table below.
- Then you will need to fill out the www.unifrog.org Placement Tool before 19th May 2023. o If you can't remember your Unifrog password, select reset password and enter your school email address. Check your school email for a link to log-in.
- Remember: without the Unifrog Placement Tool being fully completed and approved, you do not have a work shadowing placement.

Contacting employers

BEFORE

- Make sure you know the date of the work shadowing day
- Think about why you want to visit this organisation and what you have to offer.
- Think about what you will say beforehand. If you're enquiring face-to-face:
- Think about how you will note down important details (eg pen and paper; notes on your phone).
- Go in by yourself, rather than with a group of friends.
- Make sure you look clean, tidy and presentable.
- Speak really clearly and be polite.

Contacting an employer by email

You might prefer to contact employers by email. Try adapting the template below.

Hello [or Dear person's name eg Dear Mr John Smith]
